Plan

N.B. There's a lot of material so it would make sense to give some of this as homework.

1. Lead in

- a. Introduce theme of the lesson (“Today we are going to talk about photos”)
Do you take many photos? When?
- b. Look at whiteboard – here are some of my photos this year. What can you see?
- c. Find some good photos on your phone. Show each other some photos (small groups / mingle).

2. Pre-reading

- a. Focus on Adham photo (whiteboard). What can you see here? (pairs / 3s)
- b. T tells Ss about photo.

3. Reading Aloud / phonics

- a. Read aloud (T / choral)
- b. Focus on phonics (T points to words and asks, “What’s this? What’s the sound for this letter?”)
- c. Paired reading aloud
- d. Choral reading / ss nominated to read a line aloud

4. Reading – comprehension tasks

- a. Look at words and circle those in the photo
- b. Yes/ no task

5. Writing – controlled practice

- a. Gap-fill
- b. Jumbled sentences

6. Speaking

- a. Task-setting: you're going to speak about a photo
- b. Pronunciation: drill some useful phrases

This is friend / I love this photo / She's in the park. / She's wearing..... / We had a great time!

- c. Talk about one photo you like – show your group and speak about it.
- d. Whole class – nominate a student to talk about a photo.

7. Writing

- a. Preparation: look-say-cover-write-check task.
- b. Model the writing task by boarding a text for one student.
- c. Remove the model and instruct the group to write without copying. Add a safety net: look back in your notebook / at the worksheets / ask the teacher if you need to check the spelling of a word....but memorise the word and close your books when you write it!

8. Reading

- a. Read texts aloud in small groups.

9. Phonics – letter e

- a. Ss read words and focus on letter e. Can they identify the sounds?
- b. Whole class – clarify the sounds.
- c. Ss write the words into the table.

- d. Whole class – check the answers. Drill words in groups to emphasise how they rhyme (e.g. he, she, we).
- e. Pairs – read the words in the table.
- f. Whole class – show words in the power points for ss to read aloud (first, whole class but repeat and nominate individuals).
